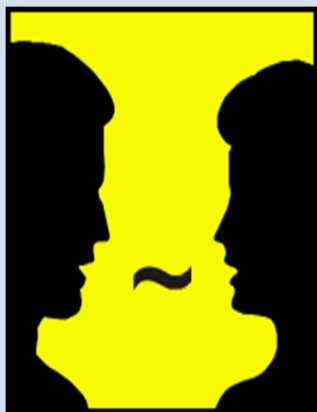


# A Right to Speak
